## Day 1—Sunday, June 13, 2021

*Travel Day to Escanaba, MI*

This morning we will travel through Wisconsin and into the Escanaba, Michigan area for our first overnight.

## Day 2—Monday, June 14, 2021

*Mackinac Island*



This morning we will depart for Mackinac Island and travel along the Upper Peninsula of Michigan to St. Ignace. This afternoon we will be boarding the ferry to Mackinac Island, which we will be calling home for the next two evenings. This charming island is three miles long, two miles wide, and transportation on the island is limited to carriage bike, horse, or foot! The island is home to about 500 year—round residents. The magnificent Victorian architecture recalls a time of days gone. This afternoon and evening you will have free time on your own to browse the different shops and sample some Mackinac Island fudge. **B**

## Day 3—Tuesday, June 15, 2021

*Explore Mackinac Island*

This morning after your breakfast buffet at the hotel, you will be able to enjoy a carriage tour. You will tour the island aboard horse-drawn carriages. Observe the Governor's Mansion, a 24 room



mansion that sits on a bluff overlooking the Straits of Mackinac. You'll also see Arch Rock, one of the most photographed spots on the island. This natural limestone formation has a span of 50 feet and rises 149 feet above the clear blue water of the straits. Our tour ends at the elegant Grand Hotel, the world's largest summer hotel since 1887. Our lunch is the hotel's fabulous Grand Buffet! This feast includes garden-fresh salads, savory cheeses, slow-roasted meats, seafood, and more than 20 varieties of fresh baked pastries. After lunch, enjoy the marvelous views from the rocking chairs on the 660 foot porch of this historic hotel and browse in the inviting gift shops. The remainder of the afternoon is free to relax, sightsee, and visit historic sites. **B, L**



### Day 4—Wednesday, June 16, 2021

#### *Cross in the Woods, Frankenmuth, Michigan*

Begin the day with a tasty breakfast buffet before we depart the island and return to the mainland. This morning we will cross the magnificent five-mile long Mackinac Bridge, which links Upper and Lower Michigan. Our first stop this morning, we will visit the Cross in the Woods Shrine. Here you will see the largest crucifix in the world—55 feet tall and 22 feet wide. It is carved from a single redwood tree and stands as the



centerpiece of this Catholic shrine in the woods of northern Michigan. The bronze figure of Jesus Christ that is attached to the cross weighs about 14,000 pounds and is the work of the famous sculptor Marshall Fredericks. The site includes several outdoor and indoor churches, numerous smaller shrines, and a doll museum. Later this afternoon, we will be checking into our deluxe accommodations at the Bavarian Lodge



Hotel. This evening you will be able to enjoy a World Famous Frankenmuth Style Chicken Dinner served family-style. Chicken dinners are what put Frankenmuth on the map and have been served for over 100 years! After dinner, you will have some free time for shopping at some of the wonderful shops in the area. **B, D**

### Day 5—Thursday, June 17, 2021

#### *Frankenmuth Guided Tour, Bronner's Christmas Store, Turkeyville Dinner Theater*

This morning you will be able to enjoy a guided tour of this German town including a stop at the St. Lorenz Lutheran Church and get a glimpse of the history that is unique to Frankenmuth. You will also be able to enjoy a stop at Bronner's Christmas Wonderland. Bronner's is



the world's largest Christmas store. You will be able to shop for that special Christmas decoration or just enjoy the spectacle of hundreds of nativity scenes and other decorations, more than 200 decorated trees, and the outdoor displays. Later this

afternoon, you will be arriving in the Battle Creek, Michigan area for our last overnight. This evening you will be able to enjoy a wonderful dinner show at Cornwell's Turkeyville USA. This evening's show will be "Right Bed Wrong Person". **B, D**
