Day 1—Monday, September 27, 2021

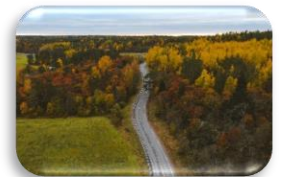
Travel Day

Day 2—Tuesday, September 28, 2021

Travel Day

This morning after our continental breakfast at the hotel, we will travel into the state of New York and this evenings accommodations will be in the Clifton Park, New York area.



Day 3—Wednesday, September 29, 2021

Norman Rockwell Museum and Yankee Candle Company



This morning after our continental breakfast at the hotel, we will head for the beautiful Berkshire Mountains in Western Massachusetts, an area culturally significant as it is picturesque. Arriving in Stockbridge, we will visit the Norman Rockwell Museum, which holds the largest collection of original works by the American illustrator with his 'Saturday Evening Post' covers. We will be having lunch on the grounds of the museum today. This afternoon we will be off to the Yankee Candle Company to view modern candle making techniques and browse the huge candle displays.

Day 4—Thursday, September 30, 2021

Travel Day to Bar Harbor, Maine

This morning after our continental breakfast at the hotel, we will depart for the State of Maine. Later this afternoon we will be arriving in the Bar Harbor Maine area, which we will be calling home for the next two evenings. Bar Harbor has the charm of a quaint, New England fishing village with all the attractions of a major port and its touristy downtown area. Watch the lobster men work, browse the souvenir shops, or explore a local museum. The town is nestled on the east side of Mount Desert Island, sheltered from the Atlantic Ocean by Frenchman Bay, and surrounded on three sides by the mountain of Acadia National Park. This evening you will be able to enjoy a Lobster Bake.



Day 5—Friday, October 1, 2021

Acadia National Park, Windjammer Boat Cruise

This morning after our continental breakfast at the hotel, we will join up with a local step-on guide for a guided tour of Acadia National Park. On this scenic tour, you will be able to explore New England's jewel. You will find granite cliffs side by side with sand and cobblestone beaches. Glacier-carved mountains rise from the sea, cupping deep lakes in their valleys. A place of matchless beauty, the park is the most famous part of Maine's ragged 2,500 mile coastline. This afternoon you will be able to enjoy a fully narrated boat cruise of Frenchman Bay. You will be able to view the breathtaking scenery of coastal Maine, Acadia National Park, the islands of the bay, and the shoreline of Bar Harbor. The rest of the day you will be able to relax at the hotel or do some shopping in the downtown area of Bar Harbor.



Day 6—Saturday, October 2, 2021

Portland, Maine Guided Tour

This morning after our continental breakfast at the hotel, we will depart the Bar Harbor area and travel to Portland, Maine area. You will be able to enjoy a narrated tour of Portland—Maine's largest city-by-the-sea. You'll see views of Longfellow's boyhood home, sea captain houses, and the elegant Victoria Mansions as you drive through historic neighborhoods overlooking the islands of Casco Bay in Portland Harbor. We will also have photo stops at two lighthouses, Bug Lighthouse and the Liberty Ship Memorial, located at Bug Light Park, South Portland overlooking at this sparkplug-shaped lighthouse. Afterwards, step back in time to view the Liberty Ship Memorial display highlighting these military ships built in the 1940's. This evening's accommodations will be in the Portland, Maine area.



Day 7—Sunday, October 3, 2021

New Hampshire, North Conway Railroad

This morning we will travel up to North Conway with incredible views of New England's Fall Foliage. Upon arriving the picturesque North Conway you will board the North Conway Railroad for a train ride on the Notch train. On the Notch Train, you'll enjoy some of the finest natural scenery in the East



as you travel through spectacular Crawford Notch-- -past sheer bluffs, steep ravines, cascading brooks and streams, panoramic mountain vistas arriving at the Crawford Depot. A boxed lunch will be included while on the train through the White Mountain Region. The ride today will be filled with some of the most beautiful fall colors of New Hampshire and Vermont. Our next stop will be a sweet stop at Morse Maple Farm where you will learn the facts about Maple Syrup and sugaring. This evening you will have free time to relax at the hotel. Our hotel accommodations for the next two evenings will be in the Burlington, Vermont area.

Day 8—Monday, October 4, 2021

Shelburne Museum, Spirit of Ethan Allen Dinner Cruise

This morning our first stop will be at the world-renowned Shelburne Museum, where you will be provided with a unique glimpse of the 18th and 19th Century American life. This evening you will be able to enjoy a dinner cruise aboard the Spirit of Ethan Allen on Lake Champlain.
