DAY 1 - THURSDAY MAY 4TH , 2020—PELLA, IOWA TULIP FESTIVAL

This afternoon we will be having a guided tour of Pella!! A local tour guide will accompany us, pointing out Pella's highlights and historic points of interest as we travel past tulip lanes, formal tulip gardens and even a stop at Sunken Gardens Park—one of many great photo opportunities. This afternoon you will have Grandstand seating for the wonderful Tulip Festival Parade and Show. You will enjoy Dutch dancing and singing, Parade of Provinces presentation of the Queen and her Court, the famous street scrubbing and the presentation of colors, before we depart Pella you will be able to enjoy an included dinner. This evening we will be able to enjoy a Pella Lighted Parade.

DAY 2 - FRIDAY MAY 5TH , 2020 - HOME SWEET HOME

This morning after our continental breakfast, we will be checking out of the hotel for home. Before departing the Pella area, we will be having a tour of the Scholte House Museum. The Scholte House is the original home of Dominie H.P. Scholte, the founder of Pella. Scholte had promised his wife Mareah he would build her a house like the elegant Dutch home they had left behind in the Netherlands. He kept his promise and within a year of their arrival, this 23 room mansion was constructed. Located behind the house are the Scholte Gardens featuring two life-sized bronze statues among 30,000 tulips. Our next stop will be at the Pella Historical Village and Vermeer Windmill. The Vermeer Windmill, at 126 feet, anchors this twenty-three building complex. The tour of the Village includes a guided tour of the mill (including the grinding and observation level) as well as a log cabin, pottery shop, General store, bakery, beautiful tulip gardens and craft demonstrations.
